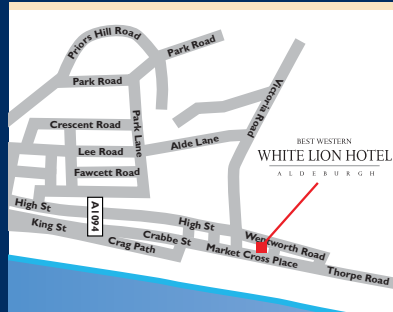
## ALDEBURGH – AN INSPIRATION TO MANY

### How to find us

**From the South:** From the M25, Junction 28, take the A12 from Ipswich heading towards Lowestoft. Take the A1094 on your right signposted Snape and Aldeburgh. Follow the road for about 15 minutes, continue past Aldeburgh Golf Club and follow the road into town. Go over the roundabout, past the church and turn left at the T junction at the bottom of the hill. You will see the Best Western White Lion Hotel on your right.

**From the North:** From the A1 at Huntingdon, take the A14 signposted to Felixstowe. After Ipswich, take the A12 signposted to Lowestoft. Turn off on to the A1094 and follow the directions above to the Best Western White Lion Hotel.
